TOWN OF CEDARBURG ORDINANCE NO. 2007-15

An Ordinance Regulating the Discharge of Firearms and Explosives.

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg has legal authority by Wisconsin State Statute 66.0409(3)(b) to enact an ordinance or adopt a resolution that restricts the discharge of a firearm; and

WHEREAS. the Town Board believes it to be in the best interest of the Town and in order to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of Town Residents to amend the Town ordinance that regulates the discharge of firearms and explosives to provide for the same requirements and enforcement language that existed in the Code prior to the adoption of the 2006 Recodification;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

§237-2 B.(1) of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

B. Discharge of firearms restricted.

(1) No person, except a property owner or his or her designee and when the property owner is present, shall discharge any firearm as above defined within the Town of Cedarburg, except when he or she has in his/her possession a copy of a written permit that is on file at the Town Hall (upon forms provided and available in the office of the Town Clerk), signed by the owner of the land, permitting the discharge of firearms upon the premises actually owned or occupied. AND, § 237-2 D. of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances is created to read as follows:

D. Any person who shall violate any of the above sections of this Code, shall upon conviction thereof, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$200 for each offense together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and posting as provided by law.
