TOWN OF CEDARBURG ORDINANCE NO. 2008-03

An Ordinance Reducing the Speed Limit on Bridge Street Beginning at Starlet Drive and Ending at the City of Cedarburg Corporate Limits.

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg has legal authority by Wisconsin State Statute 349.11(3)(c) to reduce the speed limit from forty-five (45) miles per hour to thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Bridge Street beginning at Starlet Drive and ending at the City of Cedarburg Corporate limits; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board believes it to be in the best interest of the Town to reduce the speed limit to thirty-five (35) miles per hour to protect the health, safety and welfare of Town Residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, that Chapter 305, Section-8 B(1) and B(2) of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

305-8. Speed Limits

- B. Speed limits increased or established. The speed limits are increased or established as hereinafter set forth in this subsection upon the following streets or portions thereof between the limits designated:
 - (1) A speed limit of 45 miles per hour on the following highways:

Between a point 614 feet west of the center line of Wauwatosa Road (County Trunk Highway N) and the line separating Ozaukee County and Washington County, except that portion from Starlet Drive to

Granville Road

From Granville Road west to the line separating Ozaukee

County and Washington County

(2) A speed limit of 35 miles per hour on the following highways:

From Granville Road to Starlet Drive

(the above shall be amended to read as follows)

Bridge Street

From the City of Cedarburg Corporate limits west to

Granville Road

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and posting as provided by law.
