TOWN OF CEDARBURG ORDINANCE NO. 2009-10

An Ordinance to amend Chapter 273 of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances, regarding Town recycling policy.

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg recognizes the importance of recycling for the betterment of the environment, and

WHEREAS, recycling is often a more economical method of producing goods than from virgin materials, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg encourages residents and businesses within the Town to recycle, and

WHEREAS, the Town owns and operates a Town Recycling Center to provide a place for the collection of recyclable materials, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg would like to allow Town residents that own businesses outside of the Town to be able to drop off business related recyclables at the Town Recycling Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, that Chapter 273: Solid Waste, of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

(the underlined words are to be added)

§ 273-18. Applicability.

The requirements of this article apply to all persons within the Town of Cedarburg. <u>Town residents that own a business outside of the Town may also bring business related recyclables to the recycling center.</u>

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and posting as provided by law.
