TOWN OF CEDARBURG ORDINANCE NO. 2010-1/1/2

- An Ordinance amending § 305-19, Parking Prohibited Zones, of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, particularly amending the list of prohibited parking zones.
- WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg regulates the vehicles and traffic on Town Roads within the boundaries of the Town of Cedarburg, Wisconsin; and,
- WHEREAS, there is limited shoulder area to allow on street parking in the vicinity of 236 Hamilton road
- **WHEREAS**, parking is prohibited on the southeast side of Hamilton road from the Town limits to Hamilton Park;
- WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined a need for a reserved area for loading and unloading of passengers and products for residences and businesses in the vicinity of 236 Hamilton Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, that Section 305-19, of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 305-19. Parking prohibited zones.

No person shall park, stop or leave standing any vehicle for any purpose upon the following highways or parts of highways at any time:

- A. On the south-southwest side of Hamilton Road from the Town limits to Hamilton Park.
- B. In any part of a cul-de-sac when signs have been erected at the entrance of the cul-de-sac.
- C. On both sides of Covered Bridge Road from a point 725 feet north of STH 60 to STH 60.

D. On the east side of Horns Corners Road from a point that is 1,325 feet north of the center line of Western Avenue to a point 1,525 feet north of the center line of Western Avenue, except emergency vehicles on duty.

- E. On the south side of Hill 'n Dale Court from 50 feet west of the westerly right-of-way of Clover Lane extended to 50 feet east of the easterly right-of-way of Clover Lane extended.
- F. On the northeast side of Hamilton Road from a point 250 feet northwest of the intersection with Green Bay Road for a distance of 100 feet, except for loading and unloading of passengers or property in the area designated as a loading zone.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and posting as provided by law.
