TOWN OF CEDARBURG ORDINANCE NO. 2010-5

An Ordinance to Amend Section 16-4 Library Board, of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg is a municipal body corporate and politic within Ozaukee County; and

WHEREAS, the Town works to provide access to high quality library services;

WHEREAS, the Town and City of Cedarburg no longer participate in a shared services agreement for library services; and

WHEREAS, Town of Cedarburg residents continue to have access to all Eastern Shores Library System libraries as the Town of Cedarburg pays library taxes to Ozaukee County and is considered a non-libraried community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, that Section 16-4 Library Board, of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 16-4. Library Board.

The Town of Cedarburg has an undivided 1/3 interest in the Cedarburg Library by virtue of its payment of approximately 1/3 of the cost of the library facilities. Pursuant to arrangements made If the Town of Cedarburg were to enter into a joint library agreement with the City of Cedarburg, this library serves both the City and the Town of Cedarburg, and the Town is to be represented on the Cedarburg Library Board. The members representing the Town of Cedarburg on the Library Board shall be appointed by the Chairperson, with the confirmation of the Supervisors, and shall hold office for such term as designated in their appointment. They shall be residents of the Town of Cedarburg.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and posting as provided by law.
