TOWN OF CEDARBURG ORDINANCE NO. 2013-12

An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 237 Peace and Good Order, of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, The Town of Cedarburg is a body corporate and politic; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board exercises village powers by Ch. 61, Wis. Stats.; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg regulates offenses against peace and good order; and,

WHEREAS, this ordinance would amend Chapter 237 of the Town Code in regards to hunting, fishing, hiking, sight-seeing and cross-country skiing on private lands which are designated open to public access under Wisconsin Forest Tax Law programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission recommended that the Town Board approve the proposed ordinance to the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, that the following sections of Chapter 237 of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances are hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 237-2. Firearms and explosives.

- C. The discharge of firearm restrictions stated under the above subsection (B) do not apply to persons who are hunting on private lands which are designated open to public access under Wisconsin Forest Tax Law programs.
- €<u>D</u>. Shooting ranges. This section shall not prevent the maintenance and use of duly supervised rifle or pistol ranges or shooting galleries approved by the Town Board, after an advisory recommendation from the Town Constable and Town Administrator, where proper safety precautions are taken.
- <u>■E</u>. Any person who shall violate any of the above provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$200 for each offense together with the costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days.

AND

§ 237-23. Trespassing.

C. The restrictions and regulations stated under subsection (3) and (5) hereinabove do not apply to persons who are hunting, fishing, hiking, sight-seeing and cross-country skiing on private lands which are designated open to public access under Wisconsin Forest Tax Law programs.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and posting as provided by law.
