TOWN OF CEDARBURG ORDINANCE NO. 2015-13

An Ordinance to Amend Section 78-18 and Section 16-8 regarding posting, of the Town of Cedarburg Code of Ordinances, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, The Town of Cedarburg is a body corporate and politic; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin State Legislature has passed 2015 Wisconsin Act 79 regarding the

publication of certain legal notices on an Internet site maintained by a municipality;

and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 78 and Chapter 16 of the Town Code must be updated to be compliant

with the new state law:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee, County, that the following portions of Section 78-18 and Section 16-8 regarding posting of certain legal notices are hereby amended to read as follows:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and posting as provided by law.

§ 78-18. Publication or posting of ordinances and resolutions.

A. General requirement. The Town Clerk shall publish as a Class 1 notice under Ch. 985, Wis. Stats., or post in at least three places in the Town likely to give notice to the public in at least one public place likely to give notice to persons affected and placed electronically on an Internet site maintained by the municipality, the following, within one week 30 days after passage or adoption:

- (1) Resolutions, motions and other actions adopted by the Town Meeting, or in the exercise of powers under § 60.10, Wis. Stats.
- (2) Ordinances adopted by the Town Board.
- (3) Resolutions of general application adopted by the Town Board and having the effect of law.

§ 16-8. Meetings and public notice.

- A. Regular meetings; public notice. Every board, committee and commission created by or existing under the ordinances of the Town of Cedarburg shall:
 - (1) Fix a date, time and place for its meetings;
 - (2) Send notice to the official Town newspaper in advance of each meeting of the date, time and place thereof; and
 - (3) Post by at least one public place likely to give notice to persons affected and place electronically on an Internet site maintained by the municipality on the front door of the Town Hall, an agenda of the matters to be take up at such meeting.
- B. Special meetings. Nothing in Subsection $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$ shall preclude the calling of a special meeting for good cause, but such special meetings shall nonetheless comply in all respects with the provisions of \S 19.81 to 19.89, Wis. Stats.
