WHEREAS, the Town of Cedarburg ("Town") is a political subdivision as a body corporate and politic within Ozaukee County, Wisconsin;

WHEREAS, Sec. 27-3 of the Town Code provides that "[t]he cash deposits for the various ordinances for which a citation may be issued are as established on the schedule of cash deposits adopted by the Town Board, a copy of which is on file with the Town Clerk."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Cedarburg, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, does hereby establish the following Schedule of Cash Deposits for Use with Citations Issued as follows.

Deposits shall be made in cash, money order, certified check, or other approved forms of payment to the Ozaukee County Clerk of Courts who will provide a receipt thereof.

In the absence of a scheduled or statutorily mandated deposit amount for a particular violation, the deposit amount shall be \$50 plus applicable court costs for a first violation, and \$100 plus applicable court costs for subsequent violation(s).

Any Resolution in conflict with this Resolution is hereby repealed.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
