

Ruth was one of the original Town Landmarks Commission members who wrote the successful proposal submitted to the Wisconsin Historical Society for National Register Nomination. Ruth also created original artwork and presented the documents to the State Historic Preservation Board on behalf of the Town Landmarks Commission and Town Board. The Hamilton District was listed in the National Register of Historic Places in 1976.
